

## Institutional GPA

GCSU uses the institutional grade point average for determining academic standing and eligibility for graduation. Under the institutional grade point average, students may repeat a course or courses and have only the last grade earned count towards their institutional GPA.

Institutional GPA<sup>1</sup> = total quality points earned ÷ total credit hours (GPA Hours)

Cumulative GPA<sup>2</sup> = total quality points earned ÷ total credit hours (GPA Hours)

Quality points: total quality points are determined by multiplying the number of points awarded for the grade in the course times the semester hours earned in the course. For example, a grade of “B” earned in a 3 semester hour course would earn 9 total quality points.

- A 4 points
- B 3 points
- C 2 points
- D 1 point
- F 0 points
- WF 0 points

Semester Hours Earned (Exclusive of Learning Support, Inclusive of transfer work)	Required Institutional GPA earned in courses taken at GCSU (no transfer grades included)
0-29	1.75
30-59	2.00
60-above	2.00
Graduation	2.00

**Undergraduates who meet admission requirements for GCSU, both freshmen and transfers from other majors or other institutions, are admitted directly into the J. Whitney Bunting College of Business.**

<sup>1</sup> Only the last time the course is taken is counted in the institutional GPA.

<sup>2</sup> All courses attempted are calculated in the cumulative GPA.
